I hope Everyone is coping in this unfortunate period of time. It's been tough for sure and all I can say is.....hang in there! Please keep safe and stay Healthy. I would like to take this opportunity to provide an update on what I have been doing for my Nation.

- 5.CGL-Short Term water use**

I also sit on the New Collaboration Oil & Gas Restoration Advisory Committee for Treaty 2, along with Alycia Aird-Aski Reclamation. We are starting to develop a Framework on Bumsni well sites and structure of committee. OGC willing to work with Indigenous communities to clean up contaminated orphaned wellsites. SFN has nominated and submitted to OGC, 184 sites within the Delrio area for potential clean up in the near future. The BC Government is funding this initiative with Treaty 8 nations. Oil & Gas have to also submit there annual workplans to First Nations to ensure they are going to clean up

The OGC First Nations Liaison is Sonia Sharma in FSJ and the BC OGC Commissioner is Paul Jenkins



Spruce Ridge Pipeline Project-Enbridge:

This Project is now currently under construction in Chetwynd area. This is adding a pipeline loop and additional compression to the existing natural gas pipeline system, 36 inch pipe with 24km segment and 4EG will have a construction monitor with a 2 week rotation with West Moberly until Sept-2021. Enbridge does very well with engaging with SFN TREP.

Frontier Proposed Project: Enbridge is still deciding on a route for this pipeline and the reason for that is the FNITR group is putting pressure on them regarding going through Crown lands in the Groundbirch area. We have had many meetings with Enbridge and we have voiced our concern about their proposed routes. So we are still in discussion on this. This Proposed project will be through the EAB and OGC Regulatory. SFN will be doing a TUS for this proposed pipeline as soon as Enbridge decides on a feasible route and after COVID restrictions are lifted. We hope in Fall 2021.

CGL Project-TC Energy: We have 2 SFN members Yvonne Tupper as Cultural monitor and Buddy Napoleon as the Construction monitor that are on the CGL pipeline project. I Thank Yvonne for diligently submitting her reports back to the TREP department. Brody Garbitt updates regularly on CGL with SFN. TC Energy works and follows BC Northern Health restrictions on COVID. Aecon employment opportunities posting.

Saturn Proposed Project-TC Energy: I had to reschedule the TUS interviews for this due to COVID restrictions and hopefully we can do them in January.

Unfortunately, TRSP will no longer be paying up front for any fuel, meal money or honorariums for field work in the future on some proposed projects.

BC Hydro Fish & Wildlife Compensation Program-First Nations Working Group:

I meet with this Group Quarterly but since COVID we have been doing Virtual meetings. We just reviewed and scored 30 Fish and wildlife proposals for 2021. SFN may have part in nine (9) studies-if they are awarded, The FWCP Board will make their decisions on these studies in February.
